We will all worship together in the service on Easter Sunday on April 20th. Worship bags will be available for you to pick up at the welcome center to help our youngest worshipers engage with the service.

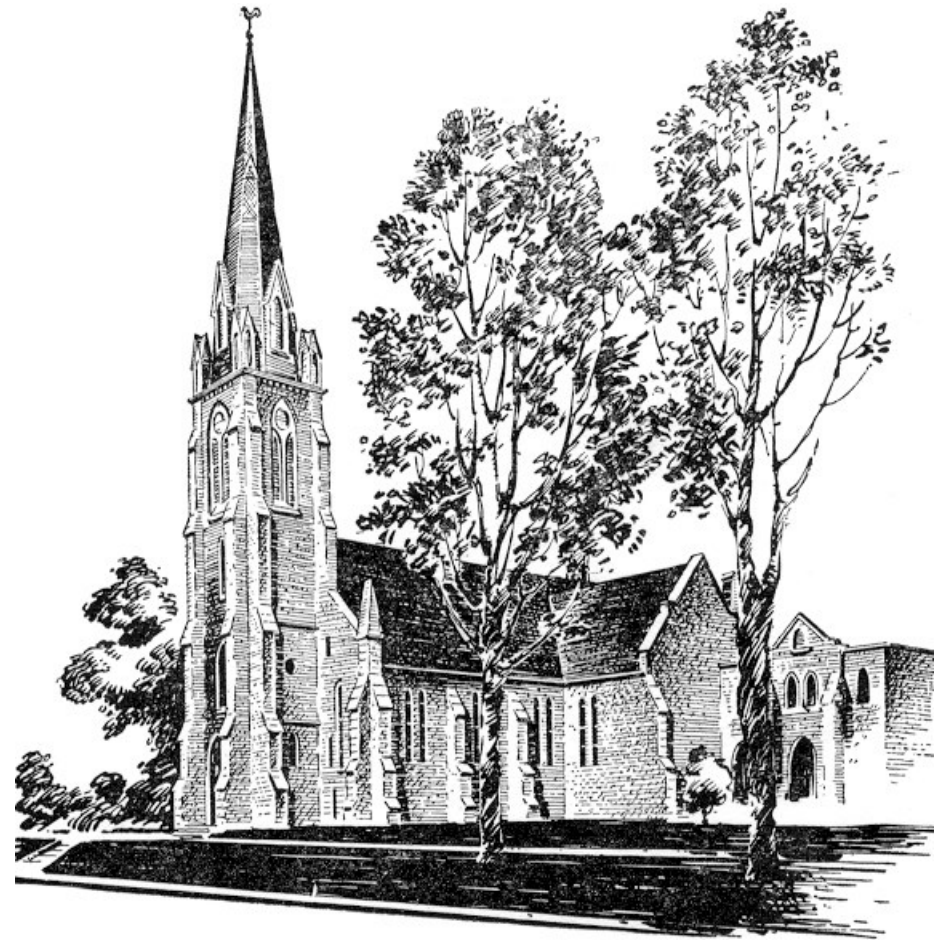

Chalmers Challenge Update: Members of the congregation are familiar with the challenge delivered by Peter Gill, Chair of Chalmers Community Services Centre when he spoke to the congregation on March 23. The MOCC later confirmed that we had accepted the challenge and we were just waiting for some additional information from Chalmers so that we could officially launch the 2014 "campaign". In 2013, we donated 935 pounds of food to Chalmers and Peter challenged us to increase that to 1,200 pounds (100 pounds per month). Our 2014 goal is therefore 1,200 pounds and to the end of March, we have donated 117 pounds. That leaves us with 1083 pounds to deliver over the next 9 months. Some members donate money to St. Andrew's for Chalmers and Jim Rife (who is a volunteer shopper for Chalmers) has also offered to do shopping with that money so that we will donate it to Chalmers in the form of food and it will count toward our challenge. Thank you, Jim! We will keep the congregation informed of our progress on a monthly basis. MOCC
