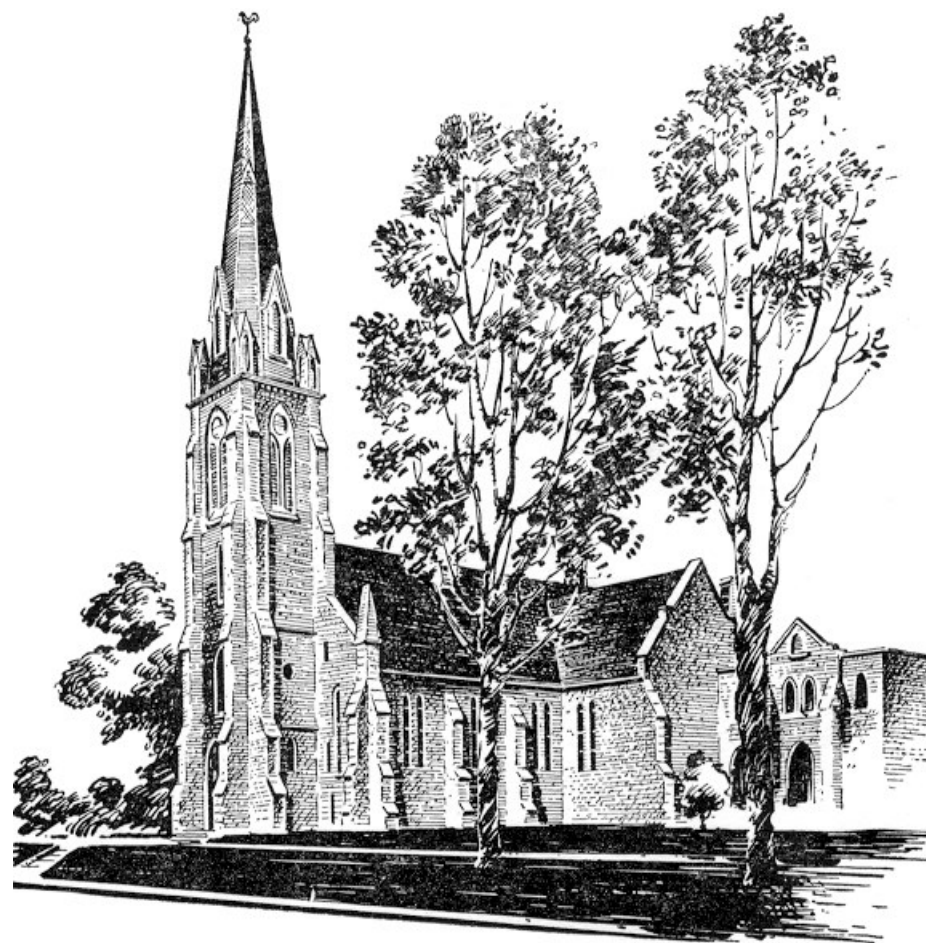

We were informed only recently that Mr. Valeriotte had raised the matter in the House of Commons on November 4, 2013. A copy of Mr. Valeriotte's letter to St. Andrew's, the Hansard record of his speech and the Government's response are on the bulletin board in the Church Hall and on the St. Andrew's website.
