Chalmers Challenge Update: In July, St. Andrew's donated 161 pounds of food to Chalmers for a 2017 total of 1673 pounds which represents 83% of our goal for the year. Praise God! We will have to donate an average of 66 pounds per month for the next 5 months to achieve our goal. During June, 145 packages of diapers were given out. 181 packages were given out in July. Diapers are paid for by St. Andrew's. Last month we reported that Chalmers Downtown would open at its new location at 41 Macdonell Street on July 19, 2017 but, that did not happen. Ongoing construction delays have continued to push back the opening date. Partial occupancy was granted a couple of weeks ago so volunteers have been able to do most of the setting up.

An announcement is expected within the next few days concerning the new opening date. Meanwhile, Chalmers West has been serving record numbers of guests – running out of some food items on most days.

Farm Fresh Eggs for sale- Some of you may have noticed the egg fridge at the Welcome Centre. The Oskam family is supplying the fresh eggs from their farm. Eggs are available for purchase at \$3 a dozen (there is a locked money box on the fridge) a portion of the sales made from the eggs is then directed back to St. Andrew's. **This fridge is for egg sales only- please do not confuse it with the egg and cheese donations for Chalmers. If you would like to purchase eggs for Chalmers from this fundraiser, please make sure to pay and move the purchased eggs to the kitchen fridge.**

On Sun. Sept. 10th we will celebrate Rally Sunday with our 3rd Corn and Dogs/Sausages luncheon.

This event will occur after the morning worship. We will welcome Rev. John back from his intersession and meet our refugee family. A double header!

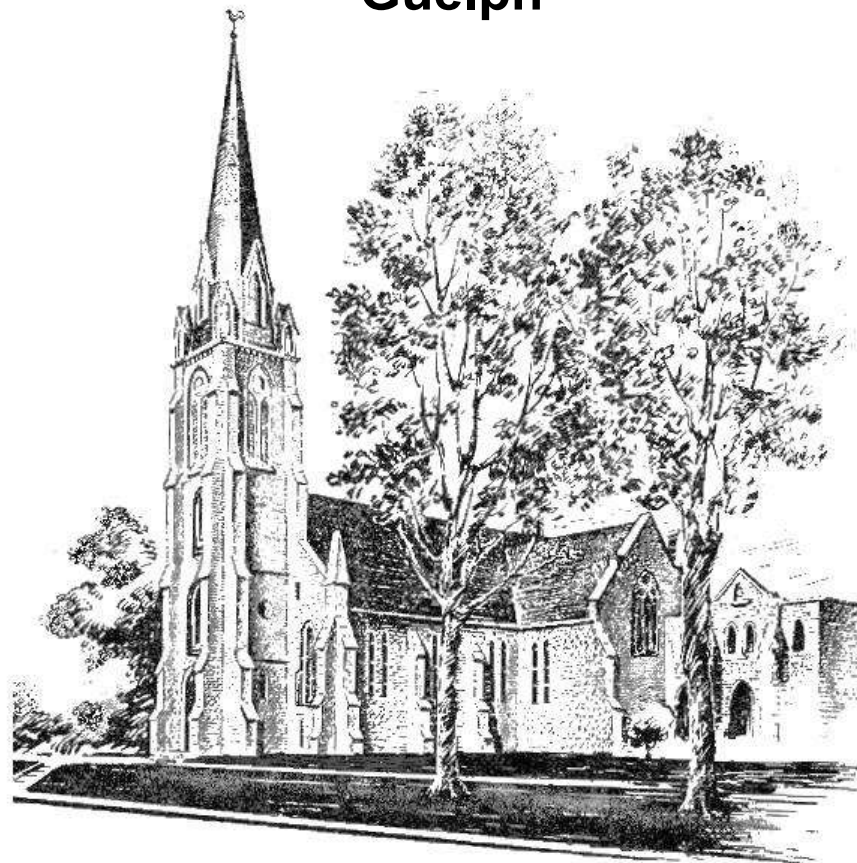
