This event will occur after the morning worship. We will welcome Rev. John back from his intersession and meet our refugee family. A double header!

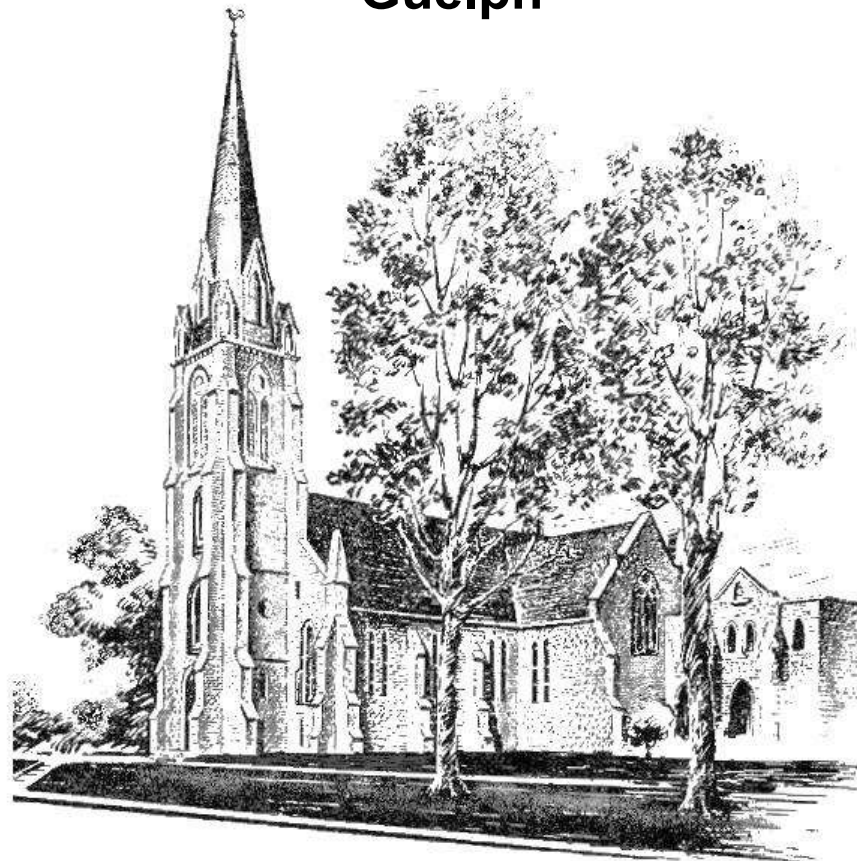
