### St. Andrew's Territorial Acknowledgement

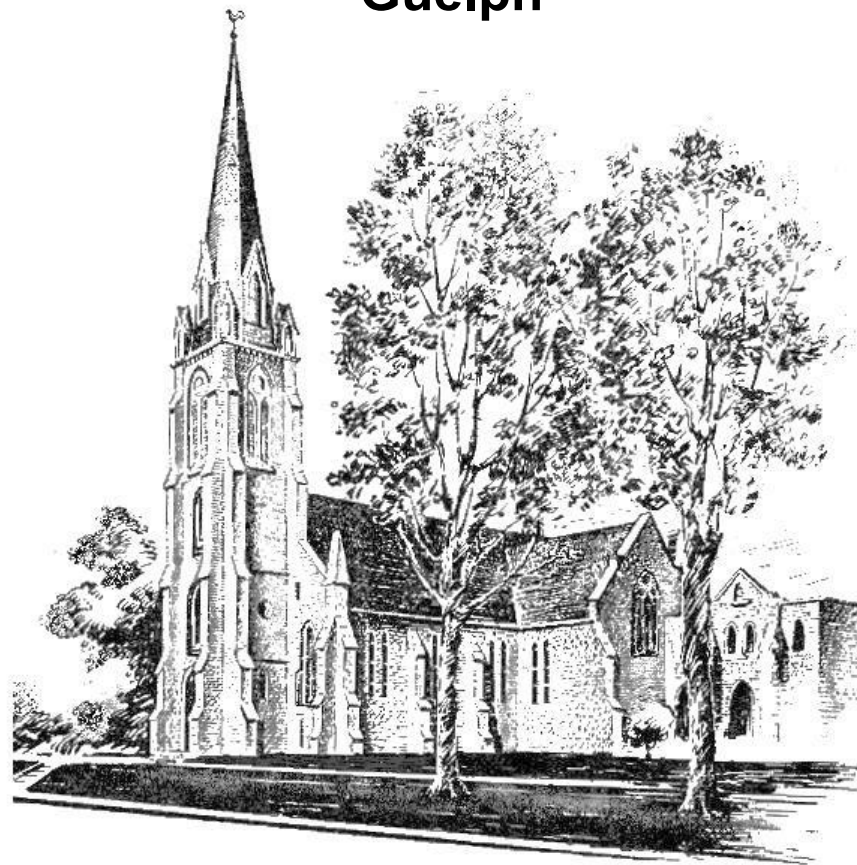
