**Notice from Board of Managers re Archives-AC project**

Last spring the Board and Session approved the "Archives-AC" project -the Archives would be relocated and AC added to the existing duct system to provide AC to the office, choir room, Minister's office and Archives Room. The financial plan was for donated funds to be matched with funds from the Memorial Fund. To expedite the projects, the Memorial fund portion was used entirely for the Archives Room relocation-which was completed during the summer 2019. Of the \$7000 required to complete the project (the AC for those rooms) only \$1200 has been received to date. The Board would like to complete the project so that AC is installed for summer 2020. Thus the Board is reminding the congregation of its commitment at last year's AGM and is asking for donations to this fund (these donations are tax deductible) so that we can begin planning the realization of having the AC completed before summer 2020.
